

The Camanche Public Library Board of Trustees is seeking a forward thinking, innovative Library Director who can continue to grow community-focused programs and services. The successful applicant will lead a staff of three (part-time) providing library service to Camanche and the surrounding area. The Director reports to a 5-member Board of Trustees and is responsible for the planning, development, implementation, and evaluation of all Library operations and services. The Director will work with the staff, Board, government officials and community stakeholders to align library services with community priorities.

An expansion and remodel of the library is being planned. The Director should have the ability to oversee that proposed expansion and remodel.

Minimum qualifications: high school graduate or G.E.D. equivalent, five years of experience in a public library with two years in a supervisory capacity. Must be certified at a minimum Level II certification from the State Library of Iowa within two years of hire.

Desired qualifications: bachelor's degree from a four-year college, or a Master's Degree in Library and Information Science or related degree. Prior experience working with city officials, budgeting, and successful fundraising.

This is a full-time (35 hrs.) salaried position with the following benefits: IPERS retirement, health insurance, paid vacation and holidays. There will be day, evening and Saturday work hours. Starting wage will be commensurate with experience and qualification.
