The City Council of the City of Camanche, Iowa met in regular session March 5, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. at the Camanche City Hall. Present on roll call: Mayor Willis, presiding, and the following named council members: Metzger, Varner, Campie, Weller and Brightman. Also present were City Attorneys John Frey and Randy Current, City Administrator Andrew Kida, department heads Hilgendorf, Reid, Schutte and Schneider.

A moment of silent prayer was observed. Mayor Willis led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Willis opened a Public Hearing for the Proposed FY 2020 Budget at 6:03 p.m. In the absence of public comments, the Mayor closed the Public Hearing at 6:04 p.m.

Receive, accept and place on file minutes from the Rose Hill Cemetery Board meeting held on February 18 2019; Receive, accept and place on file minutes from the Park and Recreation Commission meeting held on February 4, 2019; approve renewal of Class C Beer Permit with Sunday sales as submitted by Camanche Marina, Inc. effective 05/01/2019. On roll call – all Ayes.

Mayor Willis read the First Reading of an Ordinance Amending Chapter 2-14 of the Camanche, Iowa Code of Ordinances Rose Hill Cemetery. Kida explained this will effectively eliminate the function of the Cemeter Board and places it with City Hall. He said the Board was invited to attend the Council Meeting but they were not in attendance. Campie asked if Council would consider having them as an advisory committee and no one objected. The meetings would still take place but they would have no authority to spend.

Moved by Weller, second by Varner to approve the First Reading of an Ordinance Amending Chapter 2-14 of the Camanche, Iowa Code of Ordinances Rose Hill Cemetery. On roll call – all ayes.

Mayor Willis read a Resolution Approving the FYE 2020 Budget. Kida stated it has been published and nothing changed since the last submission with no increase in the tax asking. Mayor Willis thanked Kida and the Department Heads for their work on the budget.

Moved by Brightman, second by Varner to approve the FYE 2020 Budget. On roll call – all ayes.

Mayor Willis read a Resolution Setting the Time and Place for a Public Hearing on a Proposal to Amend the FYE 2019 Budget for the City of Camanche with an amendment to correct the year on the document. Kida noted this is the first amendment to the current year budget. The major amendments include Phase I of the Street Plan, reallocating salaries and the new carpeting in the Library.

Moved by Weller, second by Brightman to Approve a Resolution, as amended, Setting the Time and Place for a Public Hearing on a Proposal to Amend the FYE 2019 Budget for the City of Camanche.

Mayor Willis read the Second Side letter to Contracts for the Fire Chief, Police Chief, Public Works Director and City Clerk. Kida said the letter is in tandem with the side letter for the Bargaining Unit that was approved at the previous Council meeting.

Moved by Metzger, second by Varner to approve the Second Side Letter to Contracts for the Fire Chief, Police Chief, Public Works Director and City Clerk. On roll call – all ayes.

Mayor Willis read the First Reading of an Ordinance Amending Chapter 3-3-29 by Adding Subsection 39 to the Camanche, Iowa Code of Ordinances by Establishing No Parking on the South Side of 13th Place Between 4th Avenue and 7th Avenue. This will help to ensure the safety of the children who use the baseball fields on the elementary school property.

Moved by Weller, second by Campie to approve the First Reading of an Ordinance Amending Chapter 3-3-29 by Adding Subsection 39 to the Camanche, Iowa Code of Ordinances by Establishing No Parking on the South Side of 13th Place Between 4th Avenue and 7th Avenue. On roll call – all ayes.

Moved by Varner, second by Weller to suspend the rules of procedures to allow the waiving of the second and third readings of an ordinance. On roll call – all ayes.

Moved by Metzger, second by Weller to waive the Second and Third Reading of an Ordinance Amending Chapter 3-3-29 by Adding Subsection 39 to the Camanche, Iowa Code of Ordinances by Establishing No Parking on the South Side of 13th Place Between 4th Avenue and 7th Avenue. On roll call – all ayes.

Moved by Varner, second by Brightman to Adopt an Ordinance Amending Chapter 3-3-29 by Adding Subsection 39 to the Camanche, Iowa Code of Ordinances by Establishing No Parking on the South Side of 13th Place Between 4th Avenue and 7th Avenue. On roll call – all ayes.

Chief Schutte read the February report for the Camanche Fire Department.

Kida recognized employees for their years of service; February Anna Evans 14 years, Christy Leu 8 years, Colin Reid 2 years and March Daryl Yoder 31 years and Nate Campie 1 year. Metzger led a discussion regarding garbage and recycling services; she would like to have another meeting with Republic personnel. She thanked the Police and Fire department personnel for doing a great job. Varner said single stream recycling at the landfill started yesterday. Brightman discussed a request from the boy's baseball team.

At 8:42 p.m. the Mayor adjourned the meeting.
