Soda bottles



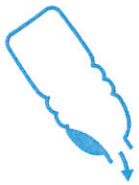
### Metal

Please make sure your recyclables are **empty, clean and dry** before placing them in your recycling container.

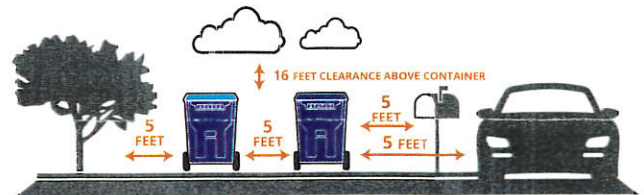
## Non-Recyclable

# 2019 Recycling & Waste Schedule

## Bi-Weekly Collection

Effective May 19, 2019, Republic Services® will be providing recycling services for Camanche, IA residents. Recycling will be collected on an every other week schedule, and all residents have been given a recycling container with a light blue lid. The first week of recycling collection will be the week of May 19, and will occur every other week thereafter. Please make sure you place all your materials at the curb by 7 a.m. on your collection day. There is a recycling guide on the back of this letter that includes a list of accepted materials. We would like to thank the City of Camanche for choosing Republic Services to be your recycling and waste service provider.
